Who qualifies for the L.M.G. Program?:

- Families must be active members of a Trinitarian church.
- Families must obtain an annual referral from their pastor.
- Families must apply for a Step Up for Students Scholarship before receiving in-house financial aid.
- New students must have an active application and be in the admission process while applying for aid.
- Families with multiple enrolled children or single parent households are more eligible.

To apply, please follow the steps below:

1. Apply for a scholarship at www.stepupforstudents.org. This approval process can take 2-6 weeks. See the section on Scholarships for Florida residents link for more details.
2. Complete the P.R.C.A. Lyvonnica McMillian Green Program Application.
3. The student must submit a one-page essay on what it means to have a servant heart.
4. Submit the Pastoral Reference Form. Parents must regularly attend and be a member of a local Christian, Trinitarian church to be eligible for P.R.C.A. aid. (If you have submitted a pastoral reference with your application, you do not have to submit again)
5. Complete enrollment for your child(ren). A student must be accepted.

Financial Award Decision: The above checklist must be completed before applications will be reviewed. Financial award recipients will be notified by email once the student has completed the full enrollment process, including the family interview and official acceptance. Award decisions will not be communicated by phone.

All payment arrangements (drafts or pay in full) must be set-up within 10 business days of award notification to claim the program award. Failure to set up payment arrangements within 10 days will result in the forfeiture of award monies. These funds will be made available to other families, and your award will have to go through the committee review process a second time.
